Board members serve a 2-year term, and are elected by members at the annual meeting, in June of even-number years. The FMYSA Board appoints Directors for one-year terms that begin in July of each year. Those interested in running for a Board position should complete this application and submit to the Nominating Committee shortly before the Annual Meeting every two years (information will be posted on the website). Volunteers interested in becoming Directors should complete this application and email it to one of the Board members. The Board of Directors will review applications and make the necessary appointments.

Code of Conduct:

All Directors are fully expected to conduct themselves according to the below code of conduct.

- Conduct yourself as a reputable FMYSA member by being fair, responsible, and respectful.
- Never use your position to intimidate or to influence any action that may affect the outcome of a game. This includes but is not limited to discussions with coaches, umpires, and/or parents.
- Counsel other FMYSA volunteers or members for their actions and/or behavior in private.
- Place the emotional and physical well being of FMYSA's players ahead of any desire to win; winning is NOT the primary objective.
- Help FMYSA promote and maintain a positive image to our members and all others in our community.
- Report to a board member any behavior of another volunteer that is not consistent with this code of conduct.
- Be a positive spokesperson for FMYSA when interfacing with the league's members and others in our community.
- Attend at least half of the regularly scheduled Board meetings. These meetings are held about 6 times a year. See www.fmya.com for day and time.
